

EUTHANASIA BY INJECTION WORKSHOP: TWO-DAY COURSE

Two-day workshops are offered in May, June, August, and October

Euthanasia by Injection is considered the most humane form of ending an animal's life. This hands-on workshop covers anesthetics, legend drugs, anatomy, verification of death, and worker safety. Attendees will learn how to perform intravenous, intraperitoneal, and intracardiac injections, as well as humane restraint. Through interactive sessions, comprehensive training, and practical exercises, the participants will also learn about and discuss the unique stress felt by those performing euthanasia. The workshop completes the state requirements for Sodium Pentobarbital Euthanasia Training.

The workshop includes:

- A variety of mannequins for hands-on injection training.
- A demonstration of safety equipment and safe restraint.
- Euthanasia content manual and a USB drive with additional resources.
- A certificate of completion upon completion of the virtual and hands-on training.

Cost:

The fee of \$250.00 includes one day of virtual instruction and a second day of hands-on training. Individuals have an option to arrange hands-on completion through a licensed veterinarian or RVT up to 30 days after workshop. Certificate of completion will be sent once confirmation checklist is received.

Day one is online and day two is in person or done at your agency.
